SUBJECT: Presidential Search Update – March 23, 2018 Meeting

The Chicago State University Presidential Search Committee (“PSC”) held its fourth meeting on Friday, March 23, 2018.

The PSC met in closed session to review forty (40) applications that had been received by that date. (An additional five (5) applications were submitted this weekend). To date, the PSC has reviewed forty-five (45) applications and identified select individuals for whom additional information will be requested.

The PSC will next meet on April 4, 2018 to conduct a secondary review of the narrowed group of candidates, and of that group will select a smaller sub-set of candidates who will be advanced to the first level of interviews.

The PSC remains on schedule to designate a select group of finalists who will be publicly identified and invited to campus to meet with the members of our university community. Thank you for your continued support and patience.
