BASIC NURSING ASSISTANT TRAINING PROGRAM

In this Illinois-approved Certified Nursing Assistant Program, students will work in all types of licensed health care facilities including nursing homes, home health agencies, hospices, hospitals, and intermediate care facilities. The program includes review sessions to prepare for the certification examination. Participants must pass a background check.
